## RECIPE TO TRY AT HOME

#### CHOCOLATE TRUFFLES

Originated from France and made its way around the world for its delectable taste and texture, the Chocolate Truffle is one of the most sought-after desserts in the world.

#### Ingredients

- 220 gm choco-chips or Chopped chocolate (60% dark)
- 100 gm heavy cream

#### Method

- In a medium sized bowl add the choco- chips or chopped chocolate
- Heat the cream using a microwave or a cooking pan. Do not boil
- Pour the hot cream over the chopped chocolate and set aside for 5 minutes
- Whisk the cream and chocolate together until smooth and shiny
- · Set in the fridge for it to set well
- Once it is set well, scoop out small balls of ganache and coat then with coco powder or chopped nuts of your choice

They are ranked no. 1 for hygiene rating and training partner in the FSSAI portal and is the only organisation chosen by FSSAI to conduct COVID-19 response training and is the food safety knowledge partner for Federation of Hotel & Restaurant Associations of India (FHRAI), South India Hotels and Restaurants Association (SIHRA) and other associations.

spread of COVID-19 and follows an extensive risk management procedure for COVID-19,in line with the Company's risk management strategy.



Jacques Cartier said the necklace for the Maharajah, a major client of the jeweler, was "a superb realization of a connoisseur's dream."
